H1N1 Vaccine Clinic

The Lee County Health Department (LCHD) has scheduled a final H1N1 clinic for the general public to receive the H1N1 vaccine and for children 9 years of age and under to receive their 2nd dose.

Date: Thursday, February 18 from 4:00 – 6:00pm

Location: **LCHD Office at 309 S. Galena Ave, Dixon**

Important: This will be our final H1N1 clinic. After this date, please call for an appointment.

H1N1 Vaccine is available in the shot form as well as nasal spray.

This clinic will allow children 9 years of age and under who had their first dose prior to January 22nd to receive a 2nd dose. The 2nd shot should be at least 28 days after the 1st dose was received.

Fighting the flu is a shared responsibility. We ask you to join us in this fight to protect yourself and your community by getting the H1N1 flu vaccine.

There will be no charge for receiving the H1N1 vaccination from the LCHD.

Clean-Wash your hands often with hot soapy water for at least 20 seconds

Cover-Cover your cough or sneeze

Contain-Stay home when you are sick
